

Regulations Governing Student Credit Transfer for IMS/IPhD (International Intercollegiate Master/Ph.D. Program) of National Tsing Hua University

Confirmed and Approved by the 3rd IPhD council on Jan 13 , 2019

Article 1. These regulations are established in accordance with the “Regulations Governing Student Credit Transfer of National Tsing Hua University”.

Article 2. Any student that meets the “Regulations Governing Student Credit Transfer of National Tsing Hua University” criteria may apply for credit transfer.

Article 3. Those credits apply for credit transfer must be taken in original school’s Master/PhD courses and received a grade of 70 or above (or above B-) and such credits were not included in the minimum requirements for graduation.

Article 4. Those credits were not taken in the IPhD/IMS program may be transferred up to 6 credits. Students must provide course syllabus and approved by the academic advisor and the dean of the IPhD/IMS program before applying for credit transfer.

Article 5. In order to transfer credits for IPhD/IMS program courses, it is limited to professional courses taught within five years. After obtaining approval by the academic advisor and the dean of the IPhD/IMS program, the credits may be transferred up to 4 courses or 12 credits.

Article 6 All kinds of credit transfers are limited to up to 12 credits.

Article 7. Those students who are approved to study abroad, exchange, internship, or to pursue a joint/dual degree, please provide relevant information and confirm with the program office in advance before taking courses. Then proceed procedures according to the regulations, without the 6 credit limit.
